

ONLINE PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy describes the practices of **Northpointe Bank** (“we” or “us”) with respect to personal information we may collect from you when you visit or use our Web sites and mobile applications that display or link to this Privacy Policy (the “Sites”), and our practices for collecting, using, and sharing that information.

Collection of Personal Information

“Personal information” is individually identifiable information about an individual that we collect online and that we maintain in an accessible form.

We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide when you visit or use our Sites including your first and last name, street address, telephone number, email address, social security number, and other information you submit through the Sites.

We also collect information automatically as you visit our Sites (“Technical Information”). We may collect Technical Information including IP addresses, geolocation data, and information collected through the use of cookies, web beacons or pixels or other tags, identifiers or technologies as they may become available or change over time.

In some cases, we may receive certain personal information from you about a third party. For example, if you apply for one of our financial products, you may provide the personal information of a third party. If you submit any personal information about another individual to us, you are responsible for making sure that you have the authority to do so and to allow us to use their personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Use of Your Personal Information

We use the Personal Information we collect to provide our services to you, to improve our services and Sites, and to protect our legal rights. In addition, we may use the personal information we collect to:

- Provide financing to you.
- Process your payments.
- Provide customer service to you.
- Maintain or service your account.
- Verify your information.
- Communicate with you about our Sites or services or to inform you of any changes to our Sites or services.
- Maintain and improve our Sites and services.
- Defend our legal rights and the rights of others.
- Efficiently maintain our business.
- Comply with applicable law.

Sharing of Personal Information

We may share personal information with third parties in the following circumstances:

- When authorized by you.
- When necessary to provide you with a product or service you have requested.
- With third party service providers retained to perform services on our behalf. These service providers are not authorized to use or disclose the information except as necessary to provide services to us.
- If we are required to do so by law or pursuant to legal process or in response to a request from law enforcement authorities or other government officials.
- When we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to prevent physical harm or financial fraud or theft, or in connection with an investigation of suspected or actual illegal activity.
- In connection with the sale or transfer of all or a portion of our business or assets to a third party.

Tracking Technologies and Advertising

However, please note that you may not be able to use all the features of our Sites if you limit the Technical Information you share with us. In addition, our Sites are not designed to respond to "do not track" requests from browsers.

Some applications and services embedded within, or linked from, our Sites are controlled by third party providers. These third parties may use cookies to collect information about you when you use our Sites or navigate away from our Sites. These third parties may also have privacy policies that differ from ours. For example, they may collect personal information about your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services, and may use this information to provide you with interest-based (behavioral) advertising or other targeted content.

We do not control these third parties' collection or use of your information or their privacy practices, and this Privacy Policy does not apply to any third party website or service you may access through our Sites.
